### TUTORING

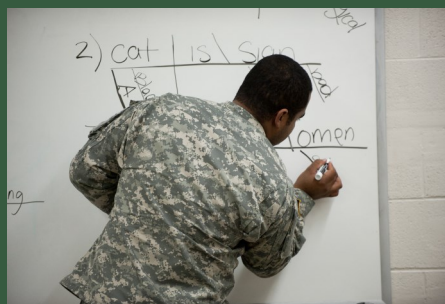

### TRANSCRIPTS

We have had a problem lately with students not submitting their high school and college transcripts within eight weeks of starting classes. If you don't submit your transcripts in a timely manner, we cannot do a formal evaluation of your transfer credits and prepare your Student Agreement which is a requirement for GoArmyEd. Subsequently, your GoArmyEd account will be placed on hold. Although you have eight weeks to turn in all transcripts, I strongly recommend that you turn in your transcripts as soon as possible.
