WHAT IS THE PGA OF AMERICA'S PGA GOLF MANAGEMENT UNIVERSITY PROGRAM?

The PGA Golf Management University Program is a four-and-one-half to five-year structured educational program designed for aspiring PGA Professionals.

The college curriculum is accredited by the PGA of America and includes extensive classroom studies, internship experience, and player development, providing students the opportunity to acquire the knowledge and skills necessary for success in the golf industry. Since its inception in 1975, more than 3,969 graduates are current PGA of America members.

PGM CURRICULUM

Students attending our PGA Golf Management Program can graduate with a baccalaureate degree in several majors, including Marketing, Business Administration, Financial Economics, and Accounting.

In addition to classroom studies, each student is required to complete approved internships totaling 16 months at golf industry locales. Students also are required to complete all requirements of the PGA of America's Professional Golf Management (PGM) Program and pass the PGA Playing Ability Test (PAT). These requirements satisfy a major portion of the PGA of America's membership requirements.
