

MY CAREER ADVANCEMENT ACCOUNT(MYCAA) SCHOLARSHIP

The My Career Advancement Account Scholarship is a workforce development program that provides up to \$4,000 of tuition assistance to eligible military spouses. The scholarship assists military spouses in pursuing licenses, certifications, or associate degrees necessary to gain employment in an occupation or career field. Spouses of service members on active duty in pay grades of E-1 to E-6, W-1 to W-2 and O-1 to O-3 who have successfully completed high school and have the ability to request tuition assistance while their military sponsor is on Title 10 military orders are eligible. Married spouses of members of the National Guard and reserves in these same pay grades are eligible.

MILITARY TRANSFER CREDITS

Methodist University awards college course credits based on service members' Military Occupational Specialty (MOS) and military education and training. All credit granted for military training is given based on the American Council on Education (ACE) guide recommendations and documented on the Joint Service Transcript (JST). Awarding of transfer credits for military education reduces the number of classes needed to earn a degree and saves time and money. Contact the Fort Bragg Office for a free evaluation.



THE GREEN TO GOLD (G2G) SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The Army ROTC Green to Gold (Active Duty Option) Scholarship Program provides eligible enlisted soldiers an opportunity to complete their first baccalaureate degree or their first master's degree and receive a commission as a Second Lieutenant.

MILITARY TUITION ASSISTANCE

Military Tuition Assistance (MTA) provides financial assistance for voluntary off-duty education programs in support of service member's professional and personal self-development goals. Soldiers use the ArmyIgnitED platform to request Tuition Assistance. Go to armyignited.com to create an account. Service members from other branches of service will follow their respective Service MTA submission processes.

Military Tuition Assistance pays up to \$250 per credit hour; up to 16 credits per fiscal year (up to \$4,000/FY).

Active-Duty military students attending our undergraduate program who have used all their tuition assistance (16 credits) with Methodist University during the fiscal year and need financial assistance to attend additional classes can request a Military Tuition Assistance Match (MTA Match) to pay for their classes. Active-Duty service members can receive up to nine credits (no more than one course per semester) while attending MU. To be eligible for the MTA Match, students must submit a current FAFSA request.
